Last year, three VDF members and VDF's president, Wendy Wong, travelled to Tibet to visit the school. Aimee, a registered nurse, taught the children the importance of good hygiene and demonstrated proper hand washing techniques. The children listened intently to these new concepts.

During the visit, they realized that access to clean water is challenging and that the kids and villagers do not maintain good hygiene. In order to collect water, the children **haul 40 gallon water jugs over hilly terrain at 14,000 ft above sea level.**

In the winter they often melt snow for drinking water and during the summer they collect water from a small spring outside the school.

With your help, the water project will provide 80 children and monks from the local monastery with access to fresh clean water from the Tibetan plateau.



Two local girls helped us wash our clothes at the spring near the school.



Momos Are Back!

The momos we served last year at our first auction were a big hit! This year a local Tibetan family will make these delicious treats: chicken and cheese momos. Cheese momos are a special delicacy that are usually served to monks.

What's a Momo? Momos are one of the most popular Tibetan delicacies. It is a steamed dumpling with vegetable and/or meat wrapped with homemade dough and have a delicate flavor. In Tibet, the whole family gather and work together to knead, roll and pack the momos. Momos are usually steamed for about 20 minutes and eaten with "Tsal" sauce, made from chopped tomatoes, cilantro, green onions, garlic and Sriracha or soy sauce.
