## Letter from our Founder

Tashi Delek (greeting in Tibetan) to my dear friends,

It has been over eleven awesome years since my husband, I and a group of compassionate friends have started Education At Elevation (E@E). With your generous support, we have made life brighter and hopeful for the impoverished kids living at a remote village at 14,000 feet above sea level in Eastern Tibet, where winter can get as cold as -20 °F. Besides, we continued to provide scholarships to two young Tibetan women to attend college through the collaboration with Tibetan Village Project.

This past August, my husband and I witnessed the overwhelming support at the Grand Puja in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia from Sonam Rinpoche's students, both local and those who traveled from China and Hongkong. With support from many in Asia together with your support here from the USA, the new school building is on its way to completion.

On a personal level, this year has been a very challenging year for my family as I have battled with breast cancer. But fortunately, I have been cancer-free since May 2019 with good access to health care. The 'karma kookies' bake sale will be pushed out to February 2020 which will line up with the Tibetan new year. We, however, will start taking the cookie orders now.

Despite this year's annual report being short and simple, we have added a new section on *Budget* for fiscal year 2019-2020 where you will see an increase in young women's scholarships increase girl scholarship and sponsoring renovation for senior housing. 

